Our next run is the Valentine's Day run, see the flyer for details and I hope to see you then.

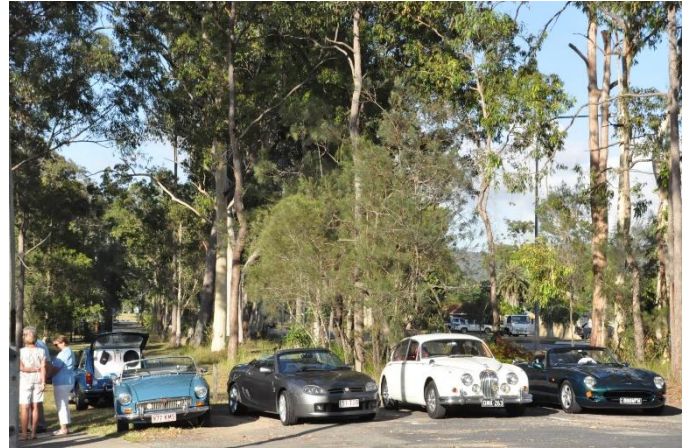
